### General Overview

This course will review potential hazards for workers who are working in or intend to work in a warehousing environment. Highlights of this facilitated discussion include: Improper stacking of products, the use of proper personal protective equipment, failure to follow proper lockout/tagout procedures, repetitive motion injuries and information on identifying hazardous materials in their work area. This training will also provide a review of protective measures for employee safety by reviewing Safety Data Sheets, and Hazard labeling systems.

### Expected Outcomes

Students will be able to identify various types of potential hazards associated with warehousing, understand warning systems used to identify hazards in the workplace, describe safe material handling practices, and identify measures designed to protect employees from exposure to hazardous chemicals in the workplace.
